


God is love and loves us even when we are not feeling good and feel that we are abandoned.

Through a series of personal exercises, Sr. Carole orients her listeners toward a deeper understanding of the whole concept of **denial** and its consequences, and proposes a solution, which ultimately is the call to spiritual integration and wholeness.

Sr. Carol demonstrates how many choose to live in **denial**, rather than face reality of life. 
and work feed our sense of being out of control and totally under attack. To deal with these realities, Sr. Riley introduces the listener to a series of meditation tech-




