Research shows that many religious people abuse their partners while quoting God or misinterpreting the Christian scriptures. Through film excerpts, case studies, and lectures, this program develops and clarifies the role of non-violent communication, conflict management, and the concepts of 'God.' 1. Refute justifications for domestic violence using 'God language' (theorists: David Richo, Bernard Mayer, Adrian Van Kaam, Marshall Rosenberg, and Patrick Carnes)

3. Define and practice non-violent communication
4. Practice 10 conflict management skills
5. Develop a resource list for personal reflection or couple's counseling
