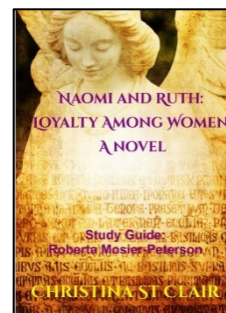

She will discuss the origin of her historical novel, [Naomi and Ruth: Loyalty Among Women](#), and also talk about the Book of Ruth from the perspective of Jewish Women theologians and scholars. She will read brief excerpts from two chapters that relate to the experiences of Naomi and Ruth, who are Biblical examples of women from different times and different countries who through their strength, wisdom, and friendship teach us all about God's enduring love.
